Sydney - This is to be sourced by students.


Queensland – University will assist with sourcing. Wharf One

#### **Clinical Practice Options – x 2**

- Option 1 Stay in Australia for the entire duration of the clinical time your year group will be completing in Ireland.
- Option 2 4 weeks will be clinical, the remainder 4 weeks will be for your own travel experience.
- 3. Complete remaining hours after the examperiod during summer 2026.
- 4. Return to Dublin after the 4 weeks placement to complete some remaining placement. Any outstanding hours will be arranged with the clinical allocations office.
- 5. This must be decided when flights are being booked.



#### Eligibility

- Must be a Senior Fresh General Nursing student of the School of Nursing and Midwifery, Trinity College Dublin in January 2026.
- Students who have not yet availed of school international opportunities will be prioritised.
- Must have passed all assessments at the first attempt (both theoretical and clinical).
- Must have a positive attitude, and be motivated, committed and engaged throughout the programme.
- Must understand the ambassadorial role that accompanies this opportunity and be prepared to represent the School of Nursing and Midwifery accordingly.
- Must be willing to present your experiences, provide photos on your return and write a 250 word testimonial for the website.

#### **Application Process**

Applicants are asked to submit a short video (Maximum length 3 minutes) either by WeTransfer or private YouTube link, addressing the following;

- Why should you be awarded this opportunity?
- What do you think you will learn?
- Why do you want to be a student nurse in Australia?
- Provide some examples of how you would manage on exchange e.g., previous travel/resilience etc.
- Provide evidence to demonstrate how you will represent the School of Nursing and Midwifery in Brisbane.
- Any additional information to support your application.
